

MARY BEAN CHILDREN AND YOUTH PLAQUE

Department Plaque presented by the Children and Youth Chairman.

Awarded to the Unit for the most outstanding Children and Youth program during the month of April.

Units must comply with following rules:

1. Plaque at all times shall be known by its original name.
2. It shall not become the permanent property of any one Unit at any time.
3. Judges to consist of three members: Department Children and Youth Chairman and two others experienced in Children and Youth activities. Judging to be completed before the Department Convention.
4. Reports must be in narrative form on 8 1/2 x 11 inch paper, typed, not to exceed 1,000 words, bound in a folder and including the following:
 - A. Newspaper clippings, pictures and other materials
 - B. Speakers and their subjects
 - C. Other organizations represented
 - D. List of material distributed
 - E. Legislative activity(A to E separate from the narrative)
5. Basis of award:

A. Cooperation with local Post Chairman	30%
B. Contributions and cooperation with other organizations	25%
C. Community activity with children	30%
D. Legislative activity	15%

(Unit reports will be judged on children and youth programs and activities during the month of April.)
