

## VETERANS AFFAIRS AND REHABILITATION

### **Lola M. Dunbar Plaque - Units with membership of 150 and under Nellie M. Baldwin Plaque - Units with membership of 151 and over**

Plaque awarded by The Veterans Affairs and Rehabilitation Chairman.

1. This plaque shall become the permanent property of the Unit winning it for three consecutive years. The permanent winner will place another plaque in the department for competition with rules and name remaining the same.
2. Judging of Unit reports for the awarding of this plaque shall be made by a committee of three Auxiliary members appointed by the Department Chairman. The committee to meet at all the call of the Chairman in order that fair competent judging may be made.
3. To qualify in competition for this plaque, the Unit must report some activity in each of the requirements on the scoring system below. The Unit narrative must be typed, not to exceed 1,000 words and received by the date so specified by the Department Chairman.
4. The purpose of the award is to stimulate interest and activity in well-rounded program.

#### Scoring:

A. Promptness of report	5%
B. Cooperation with Legion Chairman	25%
C. Report form filled in correct	5%
D. Utilization of local welfare	25%
E. Special Welfare to a Hospitalized Veteran	30%
F. Legislation	10%
